2020-2021 School Year ITA Student/Parent Contract

The agreements contained in this packet are made between the leadership of the ITA program and the students and parents that will attend the program for the above stated school year. Please return this signed top sheet as your acceptance and acknowledgment of each of the policies listed and attached in this packet.

Academics

It is understood that students are expected to maintain a 2.5 GPA or above while in the ITA program. Students that do not maintain a minimum of a 2.5 GPA will be placed on an Academic Probation contract and must improve their grades through teacher help, advisory, or other means. Any student remaining on Academic Probation for more than two card markings may be transferred back to their designated home school. Please note that ITA is a technology based program and students must have regular internet access to be successful, as many assignments and make-up work most be done at home.

Behavior

It is understood that inappropriate behavior of any kind will not be tolerated at ITA. Any student committing a Class III violation in the Student Code of Conduct may face expulsion review and may be immediately transferred back to their designated home school. Students who receive more than three days of suspension in one school year for Class I & II violations may also face transfer back to their designated home school.

Dress Code (See attached policy)

Students are expected to be in proper dress code at all times. All students are expected to wear uniform pants/skirt, a solid white collard shirt for secondary or dark collard shirt for elementary, and either a vest, sweater, or jacket depending on their grade level. Secondary students will also be required to have their school ID visible at all times. Perpetual dress code violators may be transferred back to their designated home school.

Cell Phone/Personal Communication Devices or PCD's (See attached policy)

According to district policy, the use of all PCD's (including cell phones) is prohibited on school property. Students are encouraged not to bring PCD's/cell phones to school. If you as the parent/guardian allow your student to bring any PCD to school, your student must follow the attached PCD policy and you agree to its respective disciplinary procedures.

Attendance

All students are expected to attend school regularly. Students are expected to arrive on time, remain until the end of the school day and remain in their assigned classes at all times. Students with excessive absences, tardies, skipping, or truancy of any kind may be reviewed for removal from the ITA program.

Technology (See attached policy)

All students must have their signature and parent signature below to accept the attached District technology policy. By doing so both parties agree to the terms and conditions of which are incorporated herein, and hereby agree to assume all responsibility for any liability associated with the use of systems covered by this agreement.
