To Pontiac School District families and staff:

On November 15, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) set forth new orders, which specifically incorporated the October 14th Emergency Rule promulgated by the Michigan Occupational and Safety Administration (MIOASHA), to help stop the spread of COVID-19. Several of these orders impact K-12 schools. After a careful review and consideration of these orders, here is how the district will proceed:

1. All PSD staff shall work remotely November 18, 2020 through December 11, 2020. This will exclude Food Service Workers, Security Staff as well as Facilities and Maintenance Staff, and any other essential Central Office staff.
2. All athletic activities will stop immediately.

If we receive further direction from MDHHS or MIOASHA, these plans could change. Administration will be back in contact with all Pontiac families and staff in the days leading up to December 11th, by which time we should have a better understanding of the status of the spread in our community.

Thank you for all that you are doing to keep our students safe. Being vigilant about safety is not just the responsibility of the schools. It is all of our responsibility.
