2019 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INFORMATION

Criteria

- Must be a current high school senior;
- Must be a 2019 graduate from a High School of the Pontiac School District;
 - Minimum high school cumulative G.P.A. of at least a 2.5;
 - Applicant must demonstrate merit need;
- Must write a 350-500 word essay on "What Continuing Education means to me;"
- At least three letters of recommendations from a school faculty/staff and one from the community;
 - All correspondence must be typewritten; and
 - An official high school transcript must be submitted.
- Applications are available in the High School Counseling Office and on line.

Award Amount

The award amounts will vary depending upon the type of Scholarship Awards granted. The maximum will be in the amount of \$3,000 per year for up to 2 years based upon submission of collegiate grade point average of at least 2.5 for the previous school year. All scholarship awards can be applied to any accredited community college, college, university or school of higher learning.

- Maximum award is for tuition and registration fees.
- Maximum book allowance covers fall, winter, spring and summer semesters.

The completed application and supporting documents must be submitted by Wednesday, May 1, 2019. Students can submit the application online, to the 12th grade counselor or mailed to:
