- -Must be a 2023 graduate from a High School of the Pontiac Public School

District.

Must complete 10 questions included in application.

-Must write a 350-500 word essay on "What Continuing Education means to me."

General Information:

- *Students must be a graduate from a Pontiac High School of the Pontiac Public School District.
- *At least three letters of recommendations from a school faculty/staff and one from the community must accompany all applications submitted.
- *All correspondence must be typewritten.
- *An official high school transcript must be submitted.-
- "There are fifteen (15) scholarships available for 2023 unless other funds become available.
- Applications are available in the High School Counseling Office and on line within district website.

Award Amount:

The award amounts will vary depending upon the type of Scholarship Awards granted. The maximum will be in the amount of \$3,000 per year. All scholarship awards can be applied to any accredited community college, college, university or trade school.

- -Maximum book allowance covers fall, winter, spring and summer semesters.
